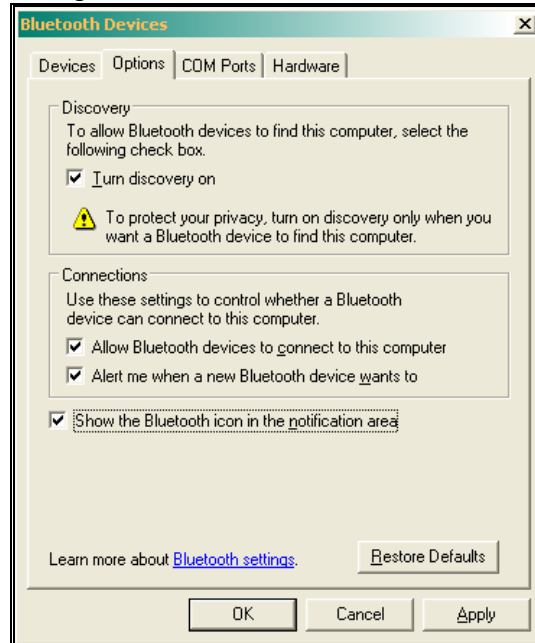


How To Transfer A File Via Bluetooth – PC To Mobile Windows XP / Vista

How to setup Bluetooth to work on your computer

1. Insert the Bluetooth dongle in the USB
2. The dongle will be detected by Windows XP
3. If the dongle is not detected you may need to install the drivers – these come with the dongle on a cd or will be available from the manufactures website
4. Once successfully installed the Bluetooth icon will appear in your system tray in the bottom right
5. Right click the icon and click settings – this may differ depending on the dongle type
6. Make sure that the settings match below

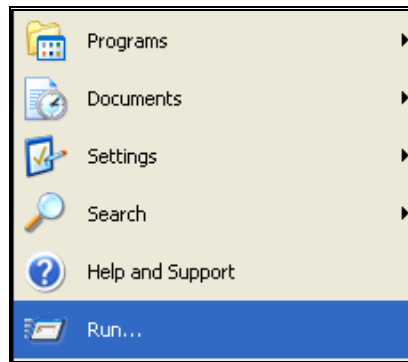


7. Switch on the Bluetooth on the mobile phone

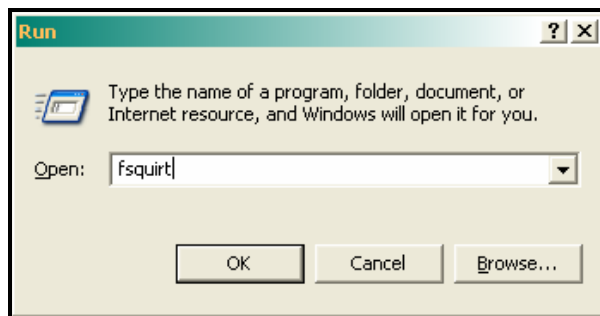
How to transfer files from your computer to a mobile phone

There are several methods in which you can send a file from your computer via Bluetooth, the following method uses the standard Windows XP process.

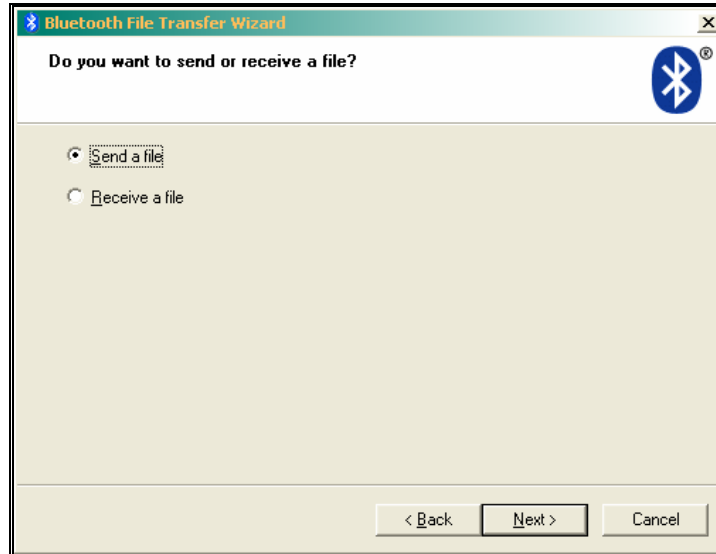
Click the **start** menu, then select **run...**



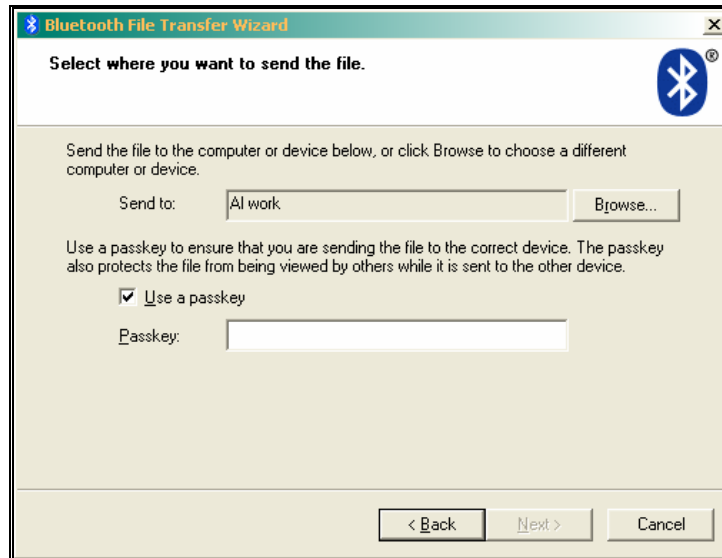
A popup box will appear, type fsquirt in this box and click **ok**



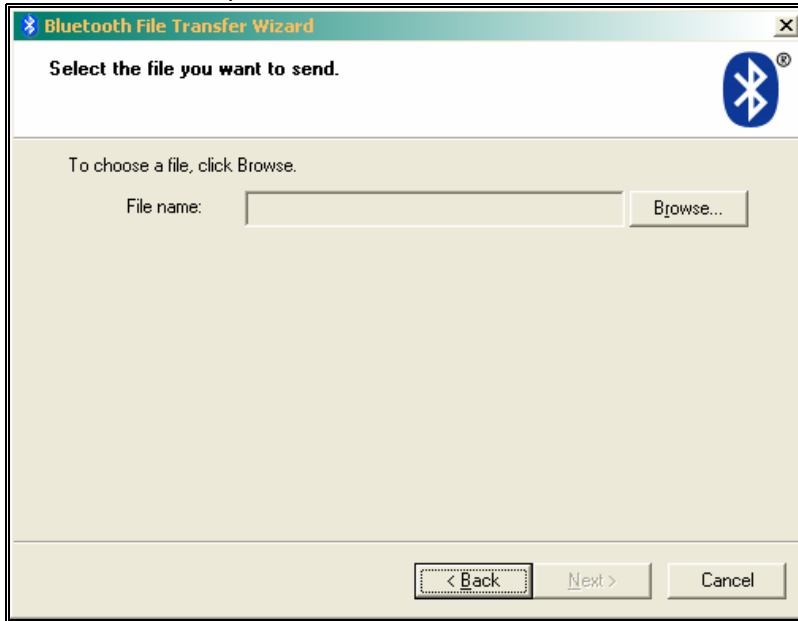
The Bluetooth file transfer wizard will appear, click **next** then select send a file



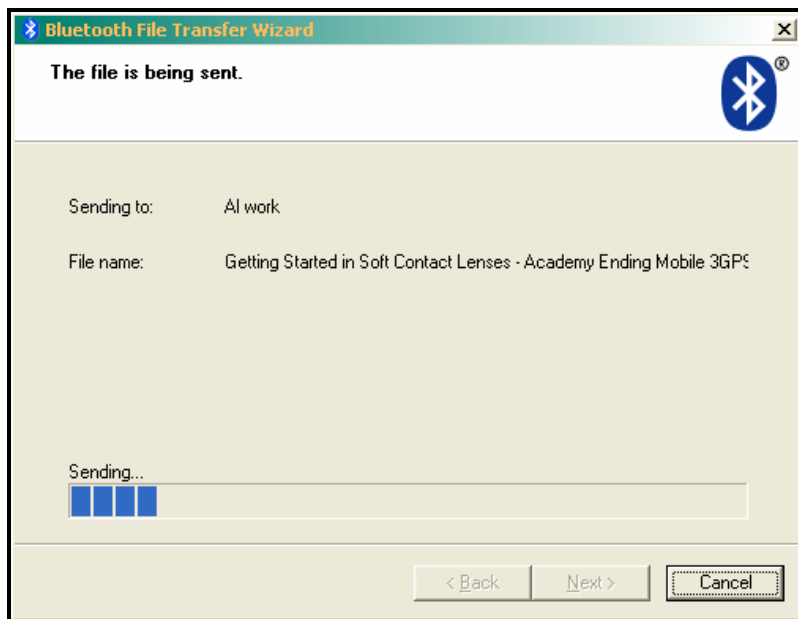
Click **Browse** in the next screen. A list of mobile phones will be shown, select the phone you wish to send the file to and click **ok**



Next click browse and select the file you wish to transfer, then click **next**



The file transfer will now begin.
